Joël Lebreton is appointed Chairman and CEO of Transdev

The Transdev group, subsidiary of Caisse des Dépôts and the 4th private operator of public transport in Europe, has today announced Joël Lebreton's appointment as Chairman and CEO. He takes over from Philippe Segretain as his term of office comes to an end.

Joël Lebreton joined Transdev when the company was created in 1991 and, until today, held the position of Group Managing Director. Instrumental in the successes of the group for 20 years, his appointment is a logical step.

Joël Lebreton will therefore continue to devote his skills and experience to the strategic development of the group, embodying a new momentum and consolidating Transdev's position as an inter-modal transport operator serving local interests.

His aims include maintaining and consolidating the group's growth while adopting an innovative approach to a perpetually changing sector. In the past, Joël Lebreton managed to negotiate a major strategic change in direction for Transdev by successfully reintroducing the Tramway in France, positioning the group internationally and developing innovative concepts (transport on demand, car-sharing, etc).

"Public transport groups are major players in the management of the economic, social and environmental challenges society is facing today. Transdev will assume an immense responsibility every day through the development of original and ambitious projects that meet all the new expectations of elected representatives and their citizens." Joël Lebreton declared.

Having graduated from the Ecole des Mines de Paris and completed his education at the Wharton School of Philadelphia, Joël Lebreton began his career as an officer at the French department of amenities between 1972 and 1974. He then held the following posts: planning manager at the Rouen development agency (ARETUR), 1974-1978; Marketing Director, then Administrative and Financial Director with the company Economie des Transports de l'Agglomération Orléanaise (SEMTAO), 1978-1983; Audit Manager, then Transport Director of Société Centrale pour l'Équipement du Territoire (SCET), 1984-1987; and finally Managing Director of Transcet, 1988-1990.

Married and with 3 children, Joël Lebreton is 59.

Transdev, subsidiary of Caisse des Dépôts, is the 4th private operator of public transport in Europe. With 12 tramway networks (Grenoble, Madrid, Melbourne, Montpellier, Mulhouse, Nantes, Nottingham, Orléans, Strasbourg, Tenerife, Utrecht, Valenciennes), 2 networks under construction (Edinburgh, Reims), and 2 metros in operation (Porto, Genoa), Transdev is a world leader on this market.
