Hubert Guyot is appointed CEO of Connexion

On 2nd December, Hubert Guyot's appointment as CEO was unanimously approved by the shareholders of the Connexion Board of Directors; this appointment was made official on 5th December.

Hubert Guyot joined Transdev in 1984 and, most recently, held the office of Managing Director of the Italian semi-public company, AMT Genova.

Hubert Guyot's work in Holland will focus on strengthening the Transdev Connexion alliance, in order to consolidate its position amongst the best public operators in Europe.

Joël Lebreton, Chairman and CEO of Transdev, congratulated him on this appointment: *"Hubert Guyot is an expert, with long-standing experience in markets as different as France, Australia and Italy. I am convinced he will be able to define a strategy in line with the Group's business plan that reflects the specific features of Connexion's historic market."*

Hubert Guyot said: *"Becoming the CEO of Connexion is a fantastic challenge: in Melbourne, Genoa and also in Grenoble, I learnt that a company's success depends on its strengths, its employees. My aim is to make the most of the synergies between Transdev and Connexion and promote Connexion's centres of excellence to develop a quality transport offering"*.

A graduate of the Ecole Centrale de Paris, Hubert Guyot began his career as a Department Manager (Sheet Metal Service) and Production Engineer with Creusot Loire (1973/1980). Between 1980 and 1984, he was an Operations Officer at the Marseille Transport Agency before joining Transdev as Production Director then Managing Director (SEMITAG, Grenoble - 1984/1993).

In 1993, he was appointed as Division Director South West France and then in 1996, he became Group Human Resources and IT Director.

He was subsequently appointed as Managing Director of the Group's Melbourne subsidiary, Yarra Trams, (1999 / 2005) and then in November 2005, he became Managing Director of AMT Genova, in Genoa.

Married with 3 children, Hubert Guyot is 59.

About Connexion:

Connexion is the number one passenger transport operator in Holland and the European leader of demand-responsive transport.

Connexion transports 300 million passengers a year, i.e. 1 million passengers a day, by road, rail or river.

Connexion has a fleet of over 7,000 buses, taxis and coaches, 27 tramways, 7 trains and 27 river shuttles.

The company employs over 14,000 people, with a turnover of 1 billion euros in 2007.

About the Transdev Group:

Transdev, subsidiary of Caisse des Dépôts, is the 4th largest private operator of public transport in Europe. With 12 tramway networks (Grenoble, Madrid, Melbourne, Montpellier, Mulhouse, Nantes, Nottingham, Orléans, Strasbourg, Tenerife, Utrecht and Valenciennes), 2 networks under construction (Edinburgh, Reims), and 2 metros in operation (Porto, Genoa), Transdev is a world leader on this market.

Present in 9 countries, in Europe and in Canada and Australia, Transdev provides transport to more than 1.2 billion passengers a year.

The Group manages a fleet of more than 20,000 vehicles, including 15,000 coaches and buses, 1,000 tramways, 90 metro units, 30 trains, 70 trolleys, 40 river shuttles and 4,000 transport on demand vehicles, a market on which Transdev is the European leader.

Transdev employs over 41,000 people, managing a turnover of 3.3 billion euros in 2008.
